INTRODUCTION

On Sunday, Vic helped us dig into our finances, and what it looks like to trust God and store our treasures in Heaven.

READ

Matthew 6:19-34

DISCUSS

1. What steps can we take to stop ourselves prioritising treasure on earth? What do you think of your giving being turned into treasure in heaven?
2. What does verse 21 tell us about our hearts? Why is our attitude about money revealing of our relationship with God?
3. Why can't we serve God and money? How can money master us? Does it help you to remember you are only a manager of your money?

4. Why do we tend to worry rather than trust God? Why doesn't Jesus want us to worry? What reasons does he give? (There are seven in this passage) How can we try to live one day at a time?

5. What is dominating your thoughts at present? Why should we be different to unbelievers? In what ways can we seek first the kingdom?

6. How much pressure do you feel to conform to our materialistic culture? How do we justify our spending? In what ways can this pull us away from God?

7. How is trust in God part of your giving? Can you recall a time when you gave sacrificially and God looked after your needs?

a) List 10 things that you can be thankful for today as a way of building trust in God as an antidote to worry.
