TAKEAWAY THE RADICAL KING Matthew 26:47-56 - Gethsemane Part 2

What would you have done if you were there?

1 Thinking they knew best2 Dividing the world into 'good' and 'bad' people (and seeing oneself as 'good')3 Trying to use 'power' to get their way.

Which of these is the biggest temptation for you?

What does all this tell us about following Jesus ourselves?

How, in this passage, does Jesus demonstrate his 'better way'?
