DESIRED OUTCOMES

To consider how the resurrection is good news for everyone

SHARE

What is your favourite film where someone 'comes back' from death?
Why is the story of a person overcoming death so powerful?

READ

1 Corinthians 15:1-14

DISCUSS

What does the passage tell us about the resurrection?

Why do you have confidence (if you have it!) that the resurrection happened?

Why is Jesus' resurrection not just news but *good* news?

If a friend with no experience of church asked what you think about the resurrection what would you say?

If we truly lived consistently in light of the resurrection of Jesus - and our own future resurrections - what would that look like? How would our short and long term decisions be different?

How does the reality of the resurrection change how we perceive and experience difficulty or even suffering now?

How does the resurrection challenge the apathy many modern Western Christians experience?

How can we keep finding joy in the resurrection day by day?
